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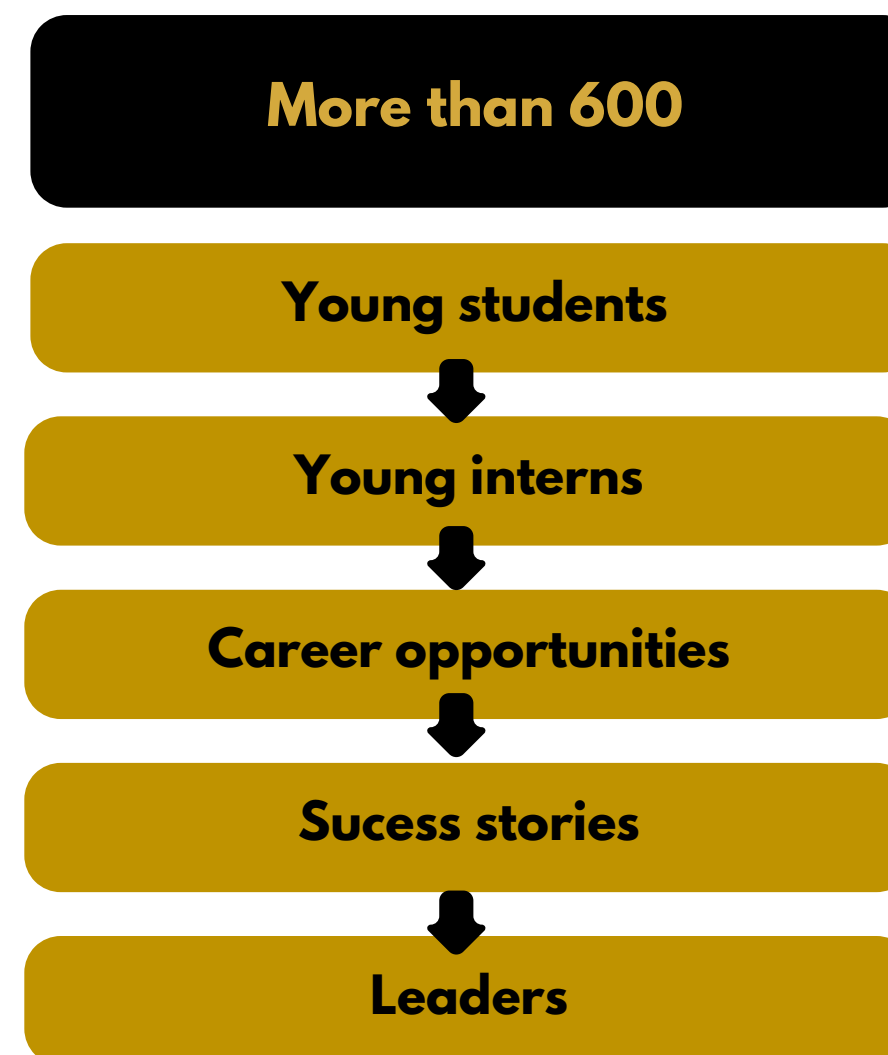

Since October 2024, HOMERe France has been officially recognized as a public-interest organization.

The association is now authorized to issue tax receipts, allowing its donors to benefit from tax reductions:

For individuals

a tax reduction of 66% of the donation amount, up to 20% of taxable income.
