- ... etc.




RMEIM's Concerns ...

Collaboration

- Collaboration is one way to answer these concerns. Good and active collaboration is a key.
- A collaboration **extends** to as many members as possible and practical (students, staff, colleges, and the university)
- Different kinds of collaboration; different interests and different potentials.
- Collaboration ; **Practical and implementable**
- Collaboration ; Sustainable



Potential Types of Collaboration/initiatives

- Joint Projects brings funding
- Staff Exchange exchange ideas and research
- Students Exchange including virtual contributes to accreditation indirect assessments; high potential for research outputs
- Micro-Credentials / Micro Diploma hands on experiences
- Industry training including virtual auto industries, construction, .. Etc.



Potential Types of Collaboration/initiatives, continued

- Mentorship initiatives offer specific services
- Students' training exchange --- HOMERe
- **Research groups** mutual interest
- Reach out for the Union for the Mediterranean have different initiatives; water, sciences developments
- **Conferences** periodic


As part of the workshop "Group Work - Discussion - Agreement - Action Plan", some of you have completed a short pre-workshop survey.



Blended Mobility Pilots – Combine a short on-site visit (1–2 weeks) with a preceding or follow-up virtual component. – Allows students or staff with limited travel budgets to still engage meaningfully. 2. Joint Intensive Summer/Winter Schools – Host 1–3-week thematic "bootcamps" on topics like smart materials, AI in manufacturing or circular economy. – Rotate the host institution each year to showcase different facilities and regional expertise. 3. Micro-Internships & Lab Rotations – Offer 2–4-week research rotations in partner labs under co-supervision. – Great for graduate students to sample different methodologies 4. "Scholar-in-Residence" Fellowships – Invite early-career researchers or lecturers from within the network to spend a semester embedded at another institution. – They teach a course, lead a small research group, and build deeper ties. 5. Co-supervised Theses and Joint Degrees

AIMS of Workshop 2

- This workshop aims to define concrete actions to strengthen collaboration among member institutions.
- Focuses on strategic areas: student exchanges, joint degree programs, co-organization of events, integration of Distance Learning platforms, etc.
- Aims to develop a model framework agreement that will support and facilitate these initiatives.

Collaboration Framework

- Solid ; Applicable ; Practical ; NOT theoretical
- Decide on options and potentials
- Need to create an action plan; implementable
- Time frame ; Expected outputs ; Follow up and monitoring
- Template
